Most video in Coub are from Vimeo but sometimes Coub upload video from SoundCloud. Every month, V2Vndb counts up the number of stolen cars reported to police. All month long we're running an installment of our data collection. In the first installment, we take a look at those numbers for August. So, what has changed? Well, the most important change is that the most stolen vehicles, overall, are now all types of electric vehicles. Let's start with the count of stolen EVs (all types) since July 1st. EVs were first stolen in May. But it's only been in the past few months that they've become part of the stolen vehicle count. Here's a look at the number of electric vehicles (all types) stolen since we began collecting stolen EV data on May 1st. As you can see, electric vehicles have been steadily gaining in numbers. In May there were about 500 stolen electric vehicles reported, in June there were 1,500, and this month there have been about 2,800. Since May 1st, there have been about 2,800 electric vehicles reported stolen. Other categories of vehicles stolen are hot cars and trucks, motorcycles, large trucks, 4 wheelers, sedans and SUVs. And yes, I'm sure there are more categories that I'm forgetting, but I'm going with these right now. Now, some of the categories of vehicles have been falling, while others are rising, over the past month. Hot Cars and Trucks: +133 Motorcycles: +121 Sedans: +63 SUVs: +62 Large Trucks: +53 Many of the big increases are electric vehicles, but there are also increases in large trucks. And this month, we've seen a drop in hot cars and trucks. So, what's happening? V2Vndb data is pretty wild, so I don't know how we got from one month to the next.
